- 2. Kim invited 13 friends to her party. If 4 were boys, how many were girls? 9, (13-4 = 9)
- 3. Round the number 551 to the nearest ten. 550
- 4. Subtract 416 from 668. **252**
- 5. I'm 9 years old. My dad is 47. How old will my dad be when I'm 21? 59 (step 1: 21-9 = 12) (step 2: 47 +12 = 59)
- 6. Add 5/8 and 3/8. 1, (8/8 = 1)
- 7. What is the best estimate for the height of a chair: three feet or nine yards?

 Three feet
- 8. What is the length of each side of a square centimeter?

 1 centimeter
- 9. What two letters follow times of day between 12 noon and 12 midnight?
- 10. Add 0.3 and 0.6. **0.9**
- 11. Give the next two numbers in this series: 2, 9, 16, 23, 30, 37 (Add 7)
- 12. Change this into a multiplication problem: 3+3+3+3=12. 3x4=12
- 13. If you have 23 ones, how many tens do you have? 2(10+10+3=23)
- 14. If you add two odd numbers, is the sum always odd or even? Even (for example, 9+9=18)
- 15. What is the quotient of 0 divided by 69?
